NEW TRAFFIC PATTERN – N64 BRIDGE OPEN TO PUBLIC TRAFFIC

On or about Tuesday October 29th, the newly constructed N64 Bridge connecting the Recirculation Road to the HOV Roadway will be open to public traffic. The new elevated roadway allows for the permanent de-signalization of the Hotel Road/Recirculation Road/HOV Road intersection, providing a seamless connection between the future Terminal One and the rest of the airport.

The existing construction detour route directing vehicles to HOV Roadway from Recirculation Road and Lindbergh Road via Hotel Road through the temporary ramp in Terminal 'A' Short Term Parking Lot will be closed. All traffic will now be directed over the N64 Bridge to HOV Roadway (see Map "A" attached).
